



## South Carolina Announces New State Procurement System: Launch July 1, 2025

The State Fiscal Accountability Authority (SFAA) Division of Procurement Services and the South Carolina Department of Administration (Admin), which operates and maintains the South Carolina Enterprise Information System (SCEIS) technology platform, are partnering with agencies to develop and launch SCPro. SCPro is a new web-based procurement system that will result in greater purchasing efficiencies statewide and will improve access to business opportunities by suppliers and small businesses. It will replace the current SCEIS Supplier Relationship Management (SRM) tool and will include a virtual marketplace that consists of online supplier catalogs which state agencies, local governments and political subdivisions can access to purchase goods and services electronically.

SCPro will launch with an initial group of agencies July 1, 2025. Agencies included in the initial launch are non-inventory and non-plant maintenance agencies.

Benefits of the new SCPro system include:

- Improved automation and technology, simplifying the functions of the purchasing system;
- A modern, user-friendly and self-service web portal with many new features and benefits to streamline procurement operations and processes;
- Ability to advance from requisition to receipt of goods more quickly and effectively, reducing the time and cost to process procurements;
- Improved customer interaction between state agency users, local governments purchasing off of state contracts and the business community;
- Improved search capabilities to find suppliers, contracts and procurements more efficiently;
- Increased transparency of state procurements;
- Improved state tracking and evaluation of contractor performance; and
- Increased supplier participation and competitiveness.

SCPro is one of several initiatives that are part of the overarching SCEIS Modernization Program. The SCEIS Modernization Program is a series of strategic projects and applications to create more modern, user-friendly, self-service solutions with many new features and benefits.

SFAA and Admin will ensure agencies are prepared for the transition to SCPro.
